### ONLINE PRESCRIPTION SERVICE - PATIENT SURVEY - MARCH 2012

We carried out a survey regarding online requests for repeat prescriptions. The survey was carried out in March with great success. 208 patients participated in the survey and 146 of those participating said they would benefit from an online repeat prescription service. Whilst 62 said they would not benefit from such a service this was either due to lack of access to a computer, or because their repeat prescription needs are already being met through other local resources.

As a result of the survey, Birchwood Medical Practice is sourcing the availability of providing this service with an aim to launch Online Repeat Prescriptions by end of June 2012.

# INFORMATION MANAGEMENT AND TECHNOLOGY (IM&T)

Birchwood Medical Practice has been inspected by the local Primary Care Trust (PCT) and has been reaccredited for IM&T. The PCT was so impressed when they assessed Birchwood that they wanted to use us as a benchmark for other practices to aspire to! To this end, our Practice Manager was asked and is consequently working with the PCT to develop a more streamlined approach to these assessments. This particular achievement is very relevant for such a large surgery as Birchwood Medical Practice.

# QUALITY AND OUTCOMES FRAMEWORK (QOF)
